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A CHANCE TO DANCE

Then again, maybe you'd like to try a little circus stuff yourself.

The **Fly-by-Night Dance Project** features a low-flying trapeze — and will give kids (and adults) a chance to try it out after its performance today at Pier 63, 23rd Street at the Hudson River.

There'll also be free music workshops at noon for kids 8 and older, and crayons and paper to draw on to capture the trapeze dancers during their 2 p.m. show, featuring six young modern dancers from the Dance Design School. Around 3:30 or so, you can play on the low-flying trapeze while the dancers spot your move.

The workshops and performances are free for kids under 18; accompanying adults, students and seniors pay \$12 a ticket; unaccompanied adults pay \$15.
